

Remote Monitoring and Diagnostic Services (RMDS)

BHEL received an order from BPCL Mumbai Refinery for the implementation of Remote Monitoring and Diagnostic Services (RMDS) for 25 assets supplied by BHEL-HPEP, Hyderabad.

The project was structured in two phases:

- Phase I included the design, development, engineering, supply, installation, and commissioning of RMDS hardware along with the required software. This phase was executed by BHEL's EDN division.
- Phase II focuses on delivering 24x7 remote monitoring services, along with periodic advisories and analytical reports to support BPCL in predictive maintenance and operational decision-making. This phase will be executed by BHEL's HPEP division

With the successful completion of the User Acceptance Test (UAT), Phase I concluded with the project going live during July 2025.

Post Go-Live, the remote monitoring services will be extended to BPCL Mumbai Refinery on an annual subscription basis, operated from the Operation Control Centre (OCC) located in External Services of BHEL-HPEP, Hyderabad.

This project marks a significant step in BHEL's digital transformation journey, aligned with Industry 4.0 principles, and reaffirms its commitment to delivering smart, value-added solutions to strategic partners in the Oil and Gas sector.

RMDS Core Capabilities:

- Real-Time Streaming Analytics for continuous equipment monitoring
- Predictive Modelling & Machine Learning to anticipate equipment issues
- Integrated Data Management supporting real-time and batch data analysis
- IoT-Enabled Asset Surveillance for seamless asset health tracking
- Expert Remote Diagnostics from BHEL's Operations Control Centre (OCC),
 Hyderabad

This centralized monitoring hub is staffed by diagnostics engineers who continuously assess live data against benchmark parameters to detect anomalies and deliver actionable insights—ensuring faster response times without adding onsite personnel.

Multi Agency Counter-Terrorist Mock Drill held at Unit's Admin Building of BHEL RCPuram

On the evening of 23 Aug 2025, the unit's administrative building became the ground for a high-intensity Counter Terrorism Mock drill, orchestrated by the elite Octopus Commandos (Organisation for Counter Terrorist Operations) an exclusive special

forces team in collaboration with CISF staff and supported by multiple emergency and security agencies. Approximately 150 personnel of various organisations wherein 80 highly trained Octopus Commandos, the most advanced and prestigious counter-terrorism force of Telangana State, spearheaded this operation.

The drill was a comprehensive exercise aimed at simulating a real-life terrorist attack scenario. The operation involved identifying and neutralizing terrorists, detecting and diffusing potential bombs, securing the installation, and ultimately giving the final clearance to ensure the safety of personnel and infrastructure.

This mock exercise witnessed seamless coordination among the Octopus Commandos, CISF personnel, Fire Department staff, Civil and Traffic Police, Bomb Disposal Squad, Dog Squad, Medical Teams with ambulances, Safety Department, HR Department, unit management, and other emergency services staff.

The Octopus Commandos employed cutting-edge technology and advanced warfare techniques to execute the drill. This included the use of state-of-the-art weapons, real-time surveillance gadgets, sniper and assault teams, cover fire units with the latest bulletproof jackets and headgear. The commandos also utilized night vision devices, laser-guided night-enabled weapons, and fully loaded communication gear, highlighting their readiness for complex and hostile environments.

The entire operation commenced in the evening and extended late into the night, conducted under dark conditions following a deliberate shutdown of the power supply to simulate blackout scenarios. The use of advanced tactical warfare procedures, combined with the integration of technology and gadgets, demonstrated the unit's commitment to preparedness and operational excellence.

This drill not only tested the readiness and responsiveness of the involved forces but also served as a critical measure to enhance the Coordination between various agencies involved, safety

protocols and emergency response capabilities of the unit.

The management of the unit expressed appreciation for the professionalism and coordination displayed by all participating agencies, emphasizing the importance of such exercises in strengthening security frameworks against evolving threats.

Inauguration of Retrofitted & Upgraded INNSE CNC Horizontal Boring M/c – TC Shop

The retrofitted and Technically upgraded INNSE CNC Horizontal Boring Machine in the TC Shop was



graciously inaugurated by Sri KB Raja, Executive Director, HPEP, distinguished presence added immense value and motivation to the event. He was accompanied by Sri P. S. S. Anil Kumar, GM/TC, HE&F & CMM, Sri N. Vijay Sagar, GM/M&S, along with Heads of Departments and members of the Electronics, Shop M&S, and TC Production teams.

This milestone project marks a significant step forward in BHEL's modernization initiatives. The machine was successfully upgraded from the obsolete Siemens 840C control system to the latest Sinumerik ONE CNC system, restoring lost functionalities and extending the machine's operational life by over 10 years.

Key Highlights of the Retrofit & Technical Upgradation:

Installation of a modern operator HMI with an intuitive interface for ease of operation.

Implementation of advanced diagnostics and IIoT-enabled features for real-time monitoring and predictive maintenance.

Integration of intelligent drive clique motors for enhanced performance and precision.

Revival of the vertical head and D'Andrea facing head functionalities, which

had been non-functional for decades. significantly reducing production cycle time.

Redesign of the operator pendant, replacing the failed hanging chain arrangement to improve reliability and ergonomics.

Restoration of the spindle gearbox to full functionality.

Recovery of ER/LT modules and cables, unlocking reusable spares worth ₹60 lakh, contributing to major cost savings.

This success was made possible through the close collaboration of the M&S Electronics, TC Shop Maintenance & Production and CMM Purchase group enabling retrofitting ahead of schedule.

The project showcases innovation, cost-effectiveness, and teamwork, enhancing the machine's reliability

and aligning with BHEL's modernization goals. It marks a proud achievement for the Electronics team, whose expertise and execution ensured significant cost savings, reduced downtime, and extended asset life supporting BHEL's vision of smart manufacturing and Industry 4.0.


